

Great Sand Lakes - Beach - Rules & Regulations

| <p>A. All property owners in Great Sand Lakes are entitled to use any of the GSLA, Inc. - owned beach areas within the boundaries of the Great Sand Lakes.</p> <p>B. Current houseguests of property owners and/or rental tenants are entitled to use beach areas as long as they observe the governing rules.</p> <p>C. Persons not meeting above criteria may not use the beach areas.</p> |

1. Parking at the Clearwater Association beach is limited to one car per household. GSLA Parking Permit must be visibly displayed on dashboard.
 2. No pets are permitted on the association beaches, including in the water, from Memorial Day through Labor Day.
 3. No tents, travel trailers, campers, or other units shall be used for habitation.
 4. No person shall disturb the peace and tranquility of others.
 5. Children 12 years of age or younger must be accompanied by an adult entitled user who is fully responsible for their behavior within the beach areas.
 6. Ball playing, kite flying, frisbee or other game playing are allowed only if they do not interfere in any way with the safety and enjoyment of others on the beaches.
 7. Boats/watercraft may only be stored in GSLA boat storage areas designated by signs. ALL of these must be removed by November first (1st). Those not stored or removed as required may be removed from GSLA property by the Board or the Harwich harbormaster.
 8. No gasoline-powered boats or other water craft may be launched from Association Beaches.
 9. No person shall be intoxicated, or commit any obscene or indecent act or use profane/obscene language.
 10. No littering; all refuse must be placed in rubbish containers provided. No household refuse allowed in-rubbish containers.
 11. No glass containers will be allowed on beaches.
 12. No person shall damage, deface, or remove any building, structure or sign belonging to the Association.
 13. No fires are allowed on the beaches at any time.
 14. Fishing is not permitted in designated swim areas.
